
#### **Front View**




	Name	Description
1	Ring Indicator	A red light indicator means that you have incoming calls or signals that a message is waiting for retrieval.
2	Dialing Pad	Press the buttons to dial a phone number or enter alphabetical characters.
3	Speed dial keys	Press to dial one touch of guest services or PBX features. Programmed during installation.
4	Flash key	Press to provide momentary line break typically used for accessing PBX features such as transfer calls.
5	Redial key	Press to automatically redial the last number dialed
