# 2 Product Description

This chapter contains important information to help you familiarize yourself with the functions of the Analog phone.

#### **Front View**



	Name	Description
1	Ring Indicator	A red light indicator means that you have incoming calls or signals that a message is waiting for retrieval.
2	Dialing Pad	Press the buttons to dial a phone number or enter alphabetical characters.
3	Speed dial keys	Press to dial one touch of guest services or PBX features. Programmed during installation.
4	Flash	Press to provide momentary line break typically used for accessing PBX features such as transfer calls.
5	Redial	Press to automatically redial the last number dialed
6	Hold	Press to hold the line without disconnect the line.

	Name	Description
7	LINE 1/LINE 2	There are two LINEs in this Analog Phone.

# 4 **Operation**

## Selecting Line 1 and Line 2

Line 1 or Line 2 can be activated by pressing one of the latching line keys labeled LINE 1 or LINE 2. Use the HOLD key to place callers on hold while connecting to the other line.

#### **Answering a Call**

An incoming call is indicated by a ringing tone and a flashing indicator at the top of handset. You can answer the call by doing one of the followings:

• Pick up the **handset** to answer the call.

## Making a Call

#### Dialing with the Keypad

• Enter the telephone number with the alphanumerical keypad.

## Using The Hold Key

#### To place a call on hold

- With a call active, press the HOLD key.
- The line LED will change from green to red indicating the call is on hold.
- Replace the handset without hanging up the call while on hold.

#### To resume the call from hold

- Press the line key of the call on hold.
- The line LED will change from red to green.

#### Changing line after placing a call on hold

- Place the call on hold, as above.
- Select the inactive line by pressing the line key.
- Lift the handset and make a call or receiving a call.
